Admission Criteria

1. What is the admission Criteria for Admission in Under Graduate program?

At least 40%, 50%, 60% marks aggregate in F.Sc/F.A or equivalent. Different %age of marks required for different programs. For details please visit the following link:

2. What is the admission Criteria for Admission in Graduate program?

At least Bachelor's Degree in 2nd div from a recognized University, or 40%, 50%, 60% marks. Different %age of marks required for different programs. For details please visit the following link:

3. I appeared in F.Sc/F.A final exam. Can I apply for admission?

Yes, we allow the students to apply for admission to undergraduate program on the basis of awaiting results.

4. What is the admission Criteria for Admission in Post Graduate program?

- Phil degree with research (18 years of education) in relevant discipline from HEC recognized University with at least 3.0 out of 4.0 CGPA under semester system or 1st Division in annual system.
- Qualifying GRE International / NTS / University devised GAT-Subject tests with score as per HEC policy at the time of admission.
- Qualifying NUML's interview.
- NUML GAT Test (At least get passing marks in NUML GAT Test).

5. Where Admission Form can be submitted?

- Print your Application and Challan Form.
- Submit Printed Application Form along with the required documents and Paid Challan form IN-ORIGINAL to NUML Admission Office, Main Campus, Islamabad or any Regional Campus.

6. Do you have entry test?

Yes, we have entry test for our all undergraduate and graduate programs.

7. Do I need to have an interview as part of the admission process?

Yes, we include the interviewer's comments in our review of your application. Interviews are required as part of the admission process, and we encourage candidates to accept the invitation.



Online Application

1. How do I apply?

- To apply NUML's intakes, you'll need to use our online application. If you've never created an account or an application with us before, use our [Sign up page](#) to get started.
- If you've created an account and an application for any semester programs, and want to apply for programs starting in the same year, you can simply [log in to your application](#) and make your desired changes.

2. How many program choice can I apply to?

You can select only one program choice on your application.

3. Can I make changes to my application?

After submission of your application you will not be able to modify. Your provided information will be saved for future modification.

4. How do I find my form number?

- When you [log in to your application](#), your form number is located near the top of the page, next to your name on your printed application

5. Can I apply twice?

- You can only submit one application per application cycle (which includes programs that run in one year).
- If you are applying for programs in a different year, you can still use your existing NUML's account, but you'll have to pay the application fee again to activate your application for the new cycle.

6. How can I check the status of my Application?

- You can [log in to your account](#) at any time to check the status of your transcripts or documents, or view or confirm an offer.
- You may receive an email when your application is verified.
- If you're waiting on an offer from NUML, you may want to contact the Admission Branch directly for an update.

7. How do I cancel my application?

Once you've created an application with us, the information can't be removed from our records. Remember, however, that until you pay the application fee, your application is not considered active and no information will be sent to the admission branch.

8. How long does it take to process an application?

This may take five weeks after last date and admission application deadline.



9. What do I do if I am having problems with the online application?
